





Martin Baltscheit: The Beard Thief





Franziska Ludwig: Do We Know Each Other? Our Secret Similarities



Can you guess what they have in common?

Everyone wears something red Everyone has a scar

- Opens our eyes and makes us curious about the people around us a kaleidoscope of everyday lives
- An anti-cliché picture puzzle book
- A great many conversation starters

Who likes to secretly pee in the shower? Some like to sort people into groups: good and bad, black and white, right and left. The result: pigeonholing, stereotypes, prejudices. However, thinking of what people have in common, opens the heart and helps imagination if you do it like the artist Franziska Ludwig. In her picture puzzle book, she guides us through the lives of 56 characters, which she keeps reorganising according to their characteristics, preferences and current life situation. Thus, on one page we see everyone who's ever had to flee (even if it was just to escape from a mountain of undone dishes), or everyone who loves a pet (even if it's the spider on the wall). And we are right in the middle of it all: By flicking back and forth, finding similarities, secrets and stories, we are able to recognise ourselves in others.





The long poem accompanies the siblings Judy and Pete through the colourful, lively Sullivan Street, where people from different cultures live peacefully and amicably side by side. One day, a little misunderstanding upsets Pete's life when his teacher mishears him, taking his father's profession for "magician" rather than "musician". This, of course, makes Pete become the centre of attention and he quite enjoys it, too. However, the truth comes out in the end and there is a lesson in it ... Abracadabra!

'Good morning! Is this seat taken?', Flux, the dragon, asks grumpy Mr Schröder, and that's how the acquaintance between the two tentatively develops. Getting to know Flux. Mr Schröder learns that it's never too late to make his dream come true. A book which needs few words and conveys a beautiful message.
