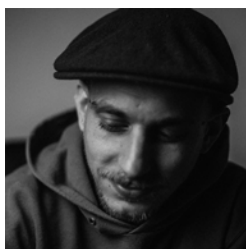
Another cracking case for Aristide!

As they stroll through festively illuminated Tokyo, Caitlyn and Jude discover that they might fall for each other despite the mix-up at the beginning.



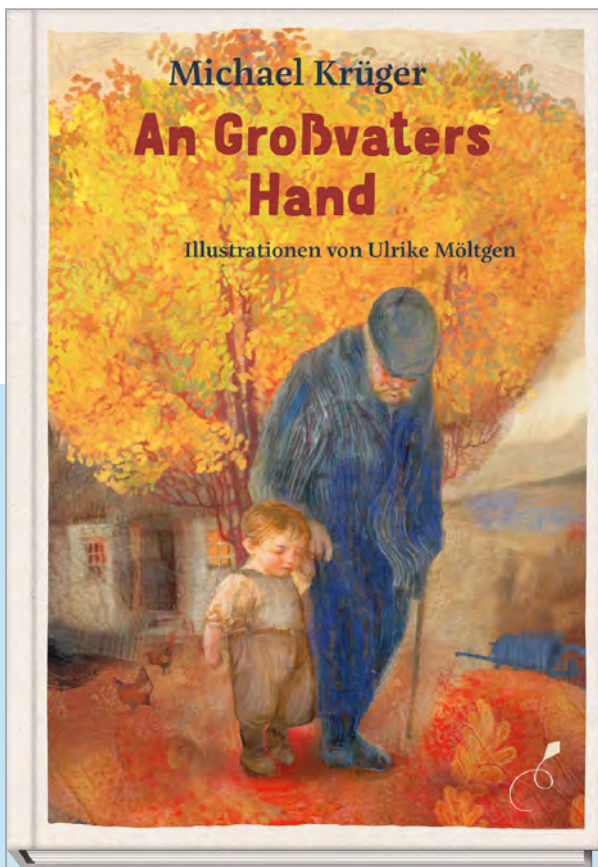
